

Square Foot Garden

Square Foot Garden is maintained on the terrace of canteen building. In urban areas the space for gardening is very less, so we are maintaining it on the terrace of buildings.

Square foot gardening is the practice of dividing the growing area into small square sections (typically 1 foot on a side, hence the name). The aim is to assist the planning and creating of a small but intensively planted vegetable garden. It results in a simple and orderly gardening system.

Green House

Maintaining of green house on the campus in order to protect the plant lets from the high and low environmental conditions such as temperature, humidity, rain fall, wind velocity etc.

Greenhouse is a structure with walls and roof made chiefly of transparent material, in which plants requiring regulated climatic conditions are grown. A miniature greenhouse is known as a cold frame. The interior of a greenhouse exposed to sunlight becomes significantly warmer than the external ambient temperature, protecting its contents in cold weather.

Maintenance of greenery: The range of activities includes all care for the outdoor greenery - mowing grass, caring for trees, bushes and shrubs, plucking flowers and woody plants, watering, weeding, including self-seeded trees, caring for raised terraces and gardens, caring of grass including gardening work. For conservation and proper watering of the plants sprinkler system was established.
