About the Programme:

The resource person explained that Economic Integration is the unification of economic policies between different states, through the partial or full abolition of tariff and non-tariff restrictions on trade. Effects could derive from currency volatility and financial market reactions.

Students were given clear understanding of Brexit issue that The Bank of England, in particular, has warned that Brexit could result in financial instability that could have damaging macroeconomic effects because of the financial openness of the UK. The impact of Brexit on the European Union (EU) will result in social and economic changes to the Union, but also longer term political and institutional shifts. The extent of these effects remains somewhat speculative until the precise terms of the United Kingdom's post-Brexit relationship with the EU becomes clear.
