### About the Programme:

Sri J. Rambabu speaking on the topic “Importance of Population to Economic Development and Reproductive Health” exclaimed that access to sexual and reproductive health services, including family planning, empowers women and girls and increases their opportunities for education and employment. This strengthens their economic security and well-being and that of their families.



Sri. P.Naresh Kumar enlightened the students on ‘World Population and Resources’. He explained that population growth is an obstacle to social development and Human Resource Development is dependent on reduced population growth rates, but rapid population growth is not an insurmountable obstacle to achieving higher levels of education. Female education attainment is particularly important for lowering infant mortality, for quality of child rearing, for labor force participation, and for use of family planning.
