Objective: To create awareness among the students about the innovation ecosystem.

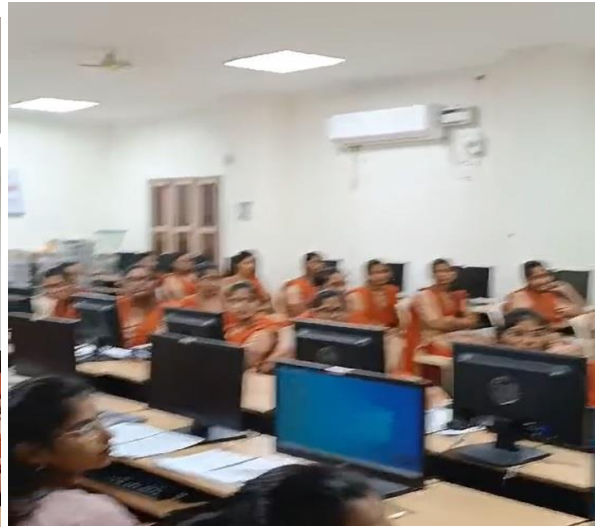
Speaker Details: Dr. Abhay Jere, VCM, AICTE & CIO, MoE
