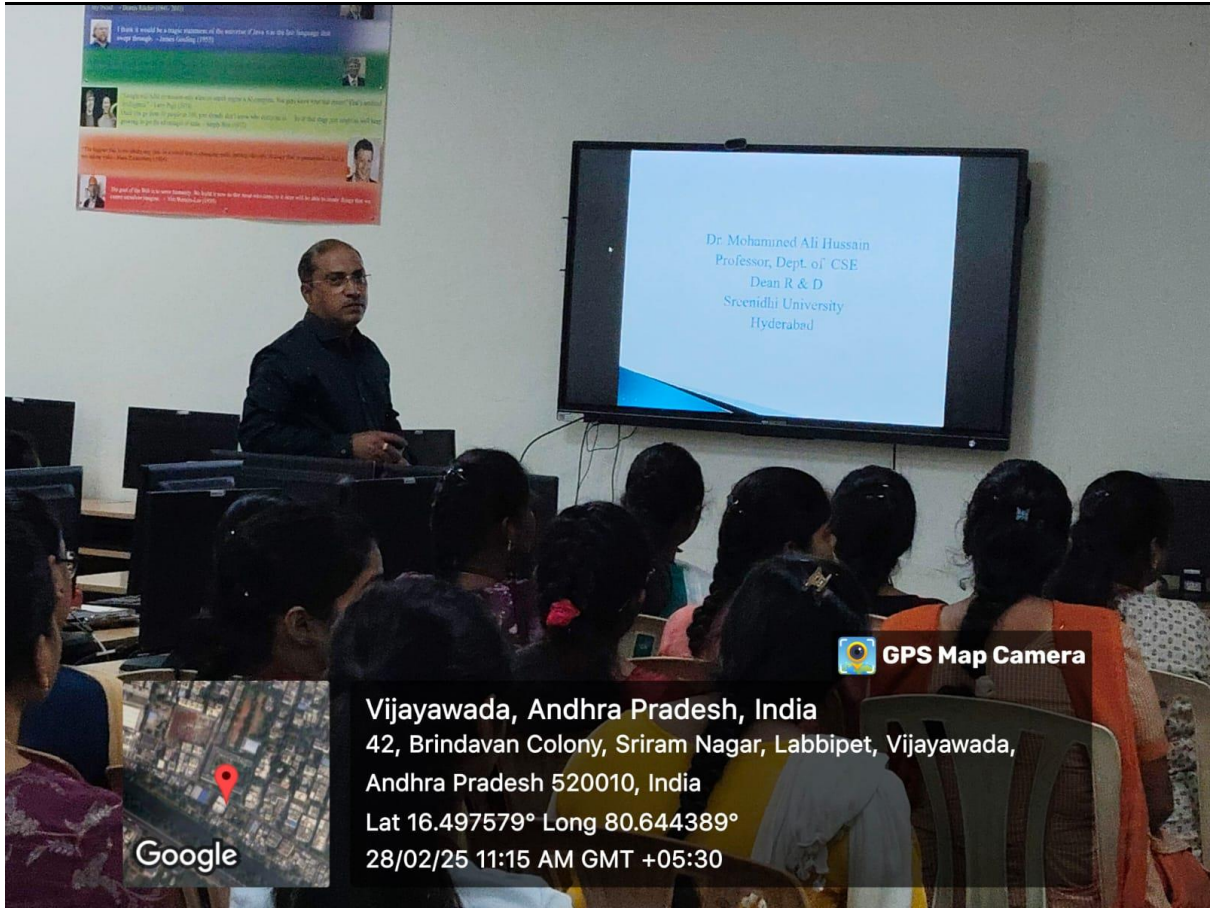
## **2.Objective of the Program**

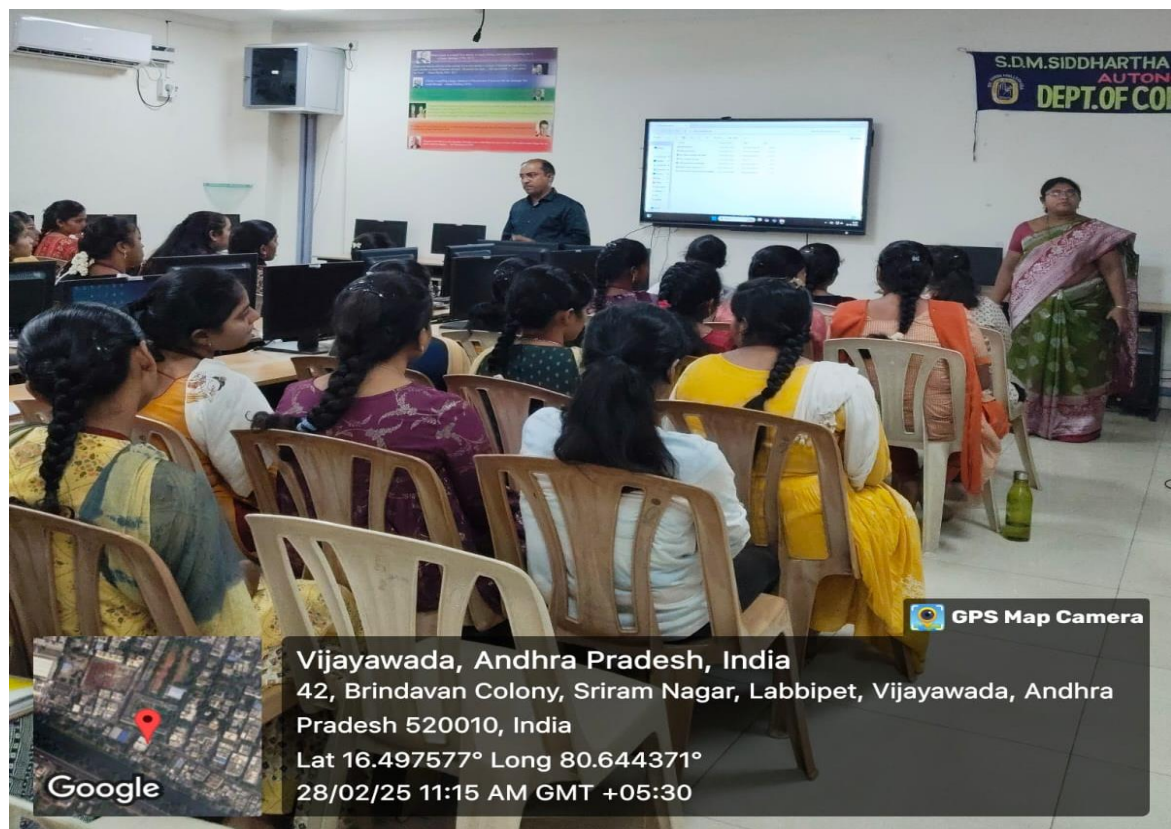
## **3.Key Topics Covered:**
